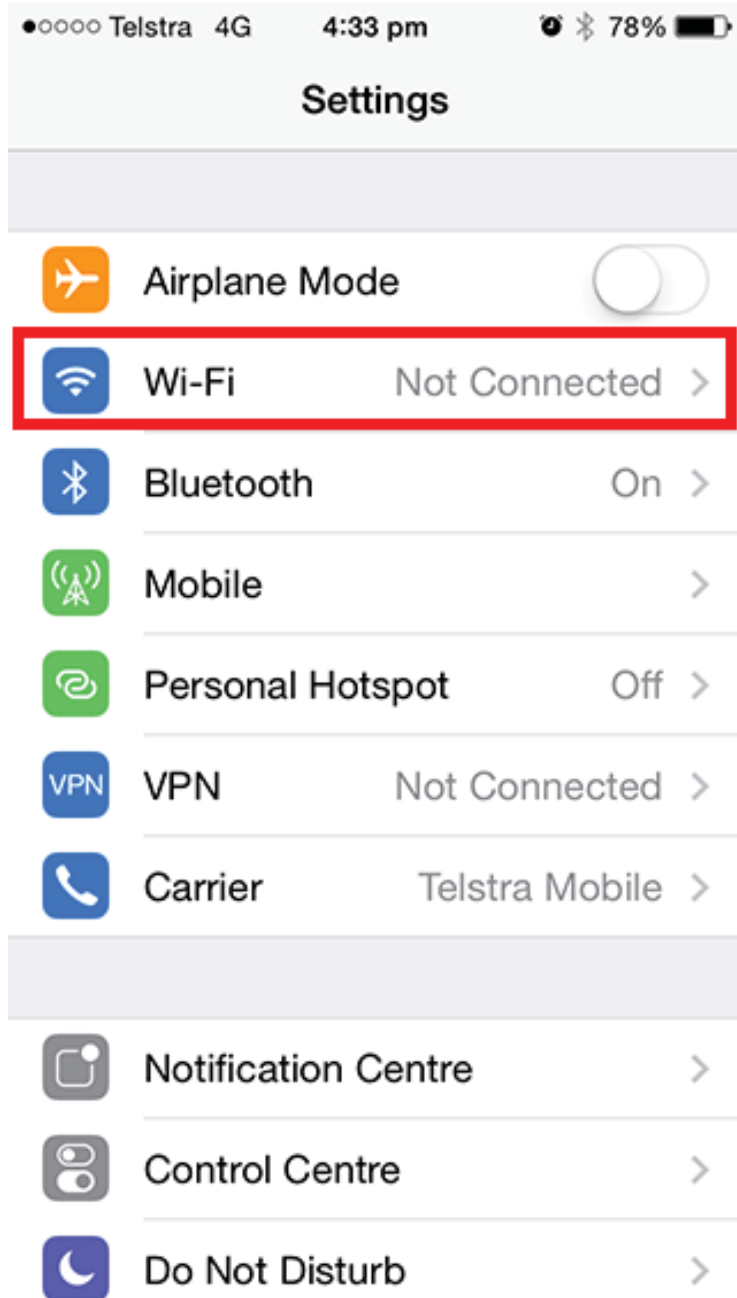


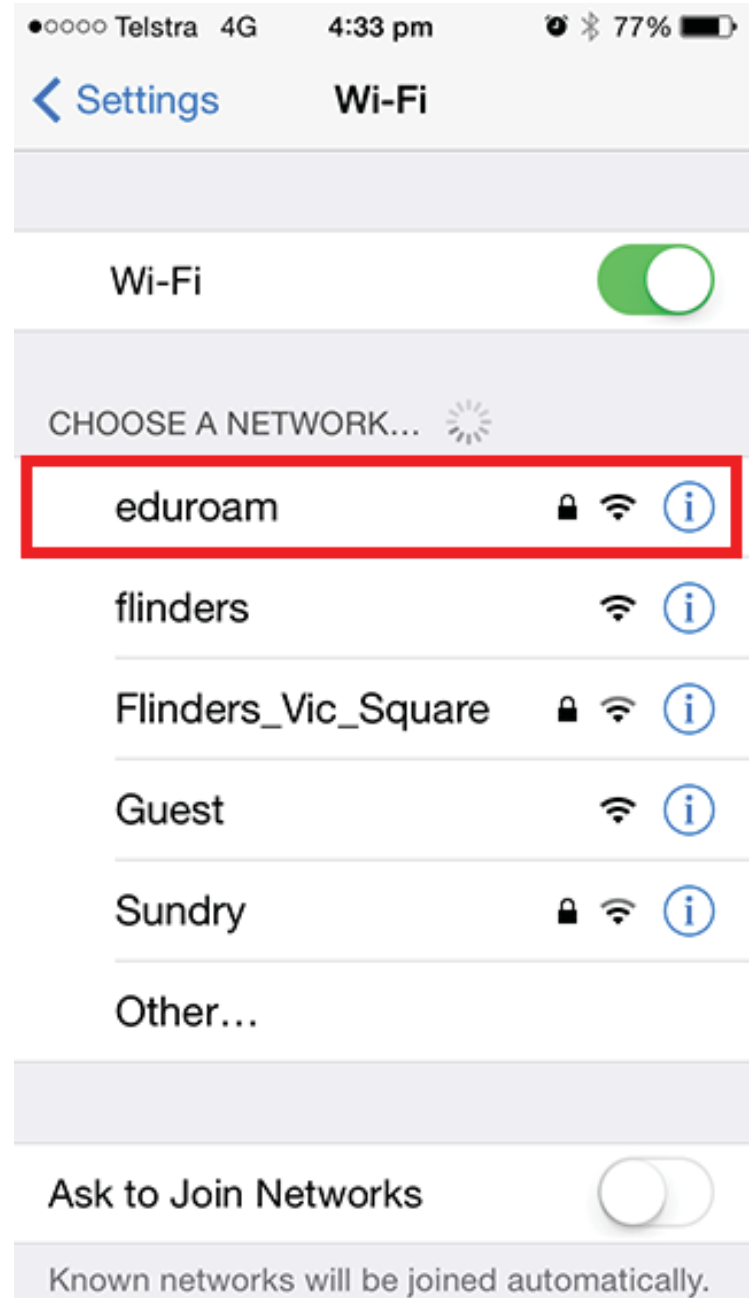
iOS Devices (iPhone,iPad,iTouch)

This guide applies to both Apple iPhones and iPads running iOS 4 and newer. The screenshots below were taken on an iPhone 5 running iOS 7 but the process is the same on an iPad or iPod Touch.

1. Go to the home screen, tap the Settings icon (it may be in a folder) and tap Wi-Fi:



2. Tap **eduroam**:



3. Enter your FAN account details, append @flinders.edu.au after your FAN username (as shown below) and then tap Join:
